

Kagoshima (Tsurumaru) Castle functioned as a residence for the domain lord (daimyo) and the domain's central government. Inside and outside of the castle were many government offices, storehouses, and other domain facilities. In the castle town, there are a large number of ruins related to modernization in the late Tokugawa period and scars from the Satsuma Rebellion.
