What are evening classes at a public junior high school?



- Classes for students to study in the evenings at a public junior high school.
- Taught by teachers licensed to teach at junior high schools.
- There are classes five days a week.
- Students study the same subjects (Japanese, mathematics, etc.) as those offered at daytime junior high schools.
- Students do not only learn how to read, write, and speak Japanese.
- Students do not have to pay tuition. Textbooks are free.
- Once students have completed all courses of study, they will receive a junior high school diploma.

Who can enroll?



- People who could not graduate from elementary or junior high school for various reasons.
 - People who graduated from junior high school but did not attend school most of the time and would like to study at junior high school again.
 - People of foreign nationalities who did not learn well at elementary or junior high school in their home countries.
- ※ Some night classes in junior high school will accept 13-15 year-old students who have not been able to attend junior high school for a variety of reasons.
