

 Kago Port Takeshima's Kago Port is on the outer rim of Kikai Caldera. It has a beautiful sandy beach and many fishes can be seen in the bay. *No entry due to a collapsed staircase



Takeshima Port

At Takeshima Port, visitors can see traces of the eruption 7,300 years ago, which ormed the Kikai Caldera. The massive geological formations you visible as sooi as you disembark from the boat testify to the magnitude of the eruption.

The six jizos were dug up and

reassembled in 1970 after they had collapsed and were buried in the bamboos at the site of Amida Temple
