Body temperature at above 38.0 degrees Celsius, cough became progressively worse (terribly bad coughing). Fatigue onset

29th March

Body temperature above 37.0 degrees Celsius, cough continued to worsen $30^{\rm th}\,{\rm March}$

Body temperature above 36.0 degrees Celsius, continued coughing, called health provider at 10:00. Underwent inspection, hospitalised at a prefectural hospital

1st April

Confirmed positive for COVID-19

Between the period of 24th March to the 26th March, the sufferer did not wear a mask

3. Current situation of the COVID-19 patient

Currently being looked after by professionals and stabilising Fever at 36.3 degrees Celsius, no symptoms of fatigue, headache – coughing intermittent
